



How to Download, Install, and Use the Feedlot Audit App

Welcome to the Feedlot Audit App, designed to streamline the audit process for cattle feedlots.

For iOS Users: To install the app, you will need to use TestFlight:

1. Click the [iOS link](#) provided to be directed to a webpage.
2. Select "View in App Store" to download TestFlight.
3. Once installed, you will see the Feedlot Audit App in TestFlight. Click **Install** to begin.
4. Open the app and follow the prompts, starting with the "From the Developer" screen where you can click **Next** to proceed.
5. You will then be prompted to create an account and sign in.

iOS updates will be launched through TestFlight. We recommend checking the NCFA website for updates periodically. If automatic updates are not enabled on your phone, you will need to follow the link to TestFlight mobile application and click the update button.

For Android Users: To install the app, follow these steps:

1. Download the APK file provided via [the link](#).
2. Once downloaded, open the APK file to begin the installation process.
3. You may need to allow installations from unknown sources in your device settings.
4. After installation, open the app and follow the on-screen instructions to register and sign in.

For **Android updates**, a new apk will be posted on the website. We recommend checking the NCFA website for new apk links. To ensure that you have the latest version of the app, we recommend uninstalling the existing app and re-installing using the latest apk on the website. This will make sure no cached data impacts your audits.

Step 1: Register Before using the app, you will need to create an account. Once registered and logged in, you can begin adding and auditing feedlots.

Step 2: Adding a Feedlot To start an audit, click the "ADD A NEW FEEDLOT" button. After adding a feedlot, you can perform either transportation or common feedlot audits.

Step 3: Completing an Audit Once the audit is complete, you can navigate to the **Final Score** screen and mark the audit as complete. Only then will you be able to export the audit report. Please note that audio notes recorded during the audit can only be edited in the exported report.

Important: Each criterion is saved after you finish the entire criterion. Exiting before completing a criterion will result in the loss of data.
